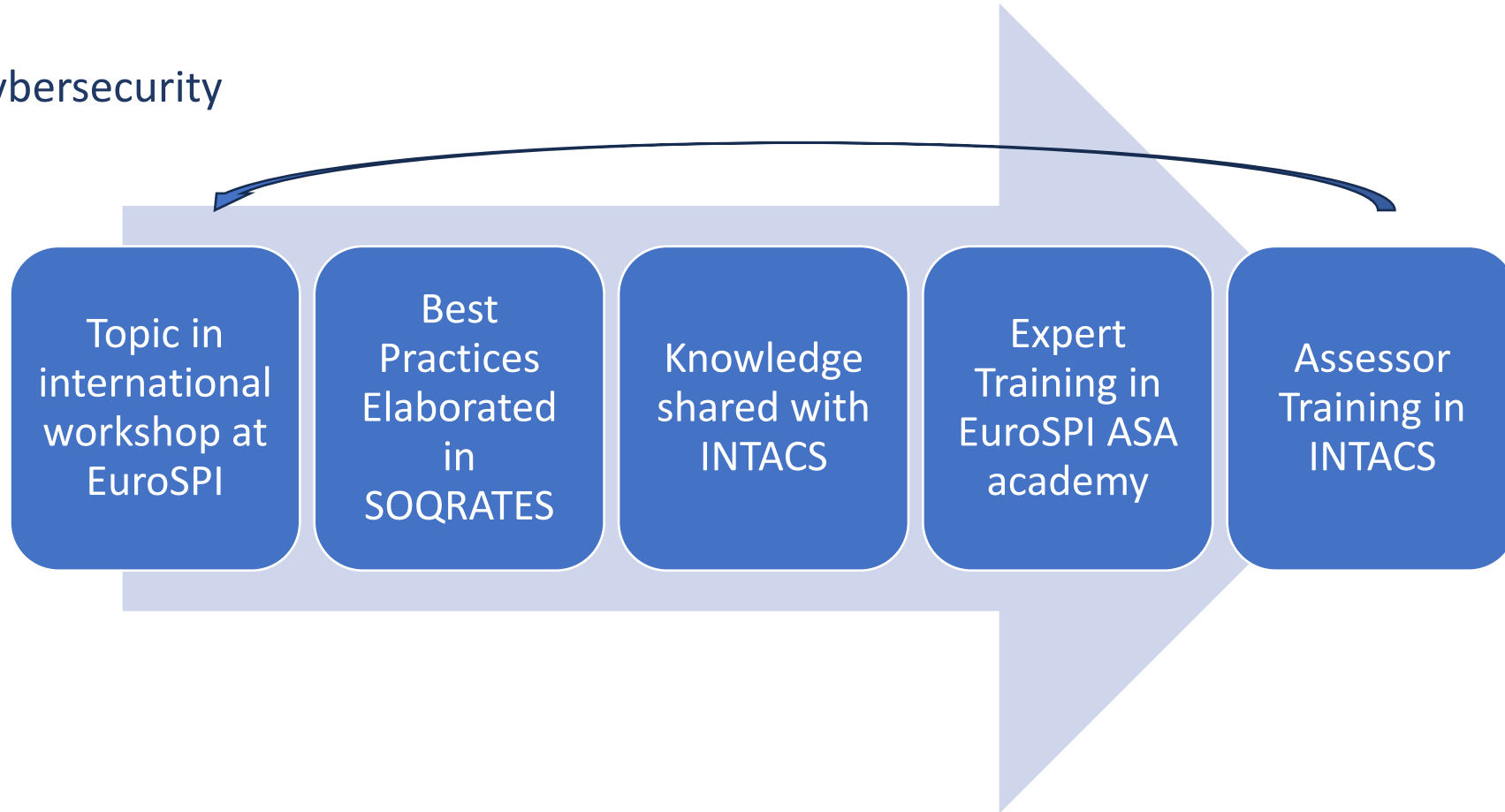

Example Cybersecurity

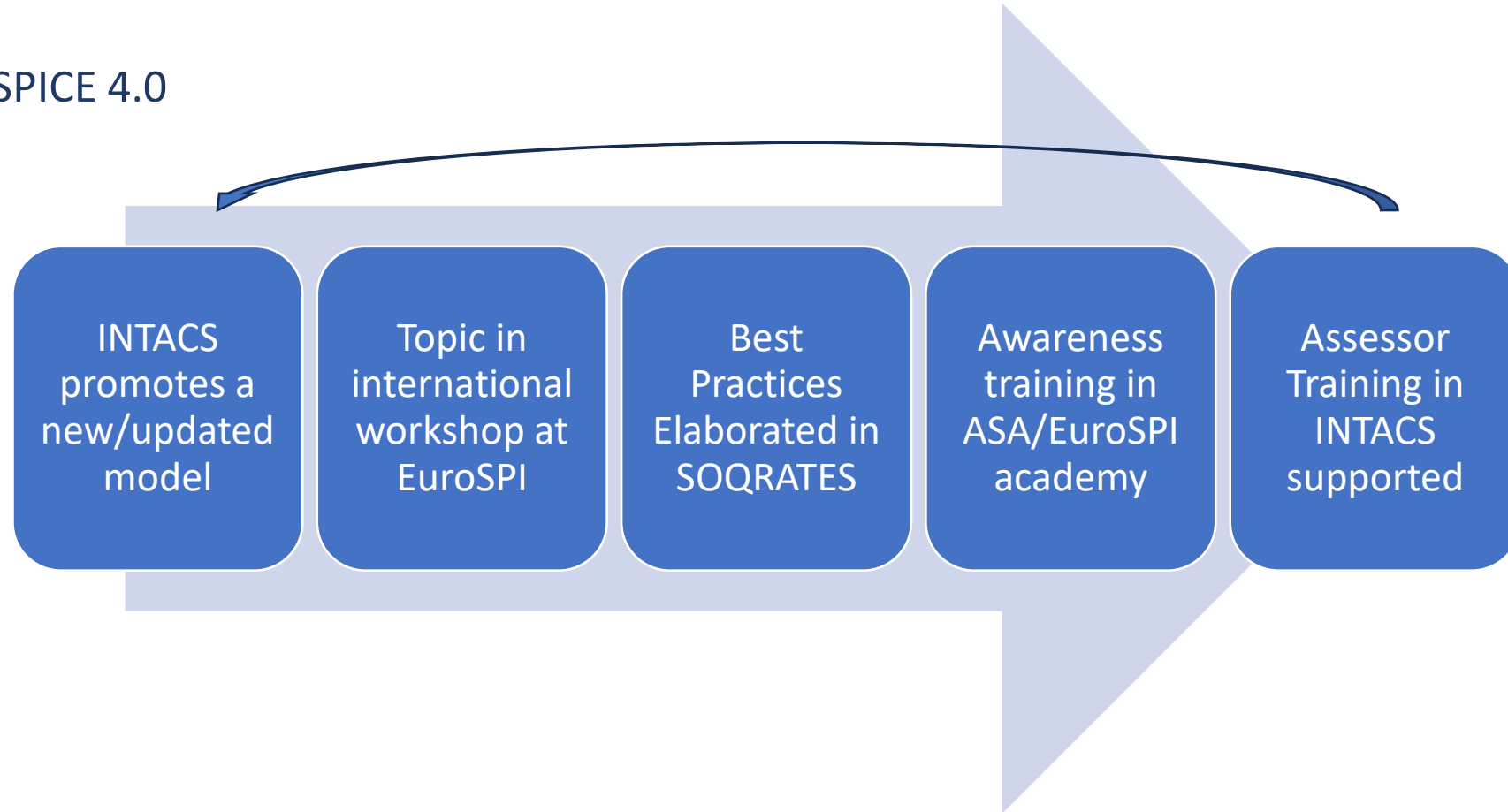

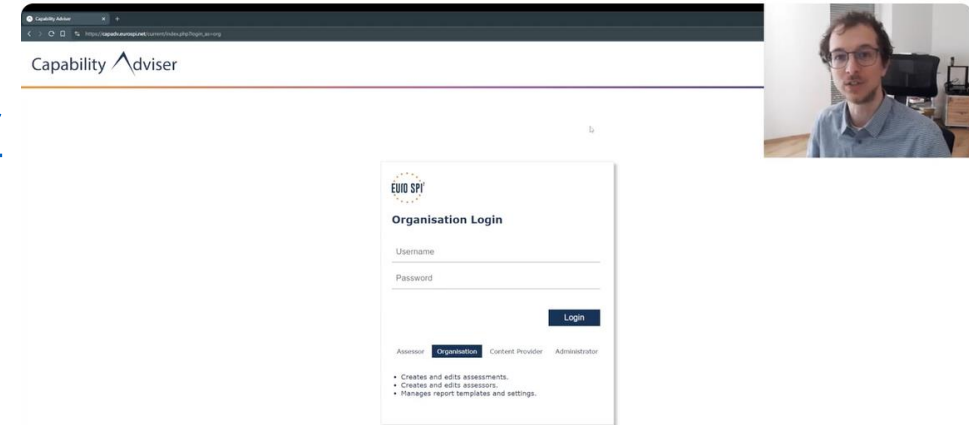
